Medieval Fantasy Faire Guidelines

Historical fantasy is a subgenre of historical fiction that incorporates fantastic elements (such as magic) into the narrative. Historical fantasy usually takes one of three common approaches:

1. Magic, mythical creatures or other supernatural elements co-exist invisibly with the mundane world, with the majority of people being unaware of it.
2. A story that takes place in an alternative history with clear differences from our own.
3. A story that takes place in a secondary world with specific and recognizable parallels to known places and a definite historical period.

Subgenres: Arabian Fantasy, Celtic Fantasy, Classical Fantasy, Medieval Fantasy

General Criteria for Participation

Each vendor will be required to provide a booth or cart typical of the implied period. Booths can range from being cloth or canvas pop-up tents, to solid structures that tie into the medieval fantasy theme.

All vendors and their employees/volunteers are required to wear costumes appropriate to medieval fantasy theme.

Attire

Applicants are required to send photos of any attire being worn by participants. All articles of clothing should fit into the themed event. Modern clothing such as t-shirts, denim jeans, sweatshirts, etc. is prohibited.

Booth Design

Applicants are required to send detailed sketches or photos of your booth design. The measurements for height, depth and width must be included. Please include front and side views of your booth. It is also recommended that you provide space requests for the back of your booth.

Camping and Lodging

Overnight Parking and Camping are not permitted. For camping and lodging please see the attached page.

Crafts / Imports

It is the intention of the Faire to have crafts and imports that complement and blend with our Medieval Fantasy theme. Please note that any photos or drawings will be kept on file and will not be returned. Contemporary items such as sunglasses, battery operated toys, modern clothing, etc. are prohibited. Items that are encouraged, but not limited to are as follows: Handmade crafts, fantasy/ medieval/ renaissance apparel, fantasy based novelty items, etc.

Games / Activities

Presentation and context of your game or activity should relate to fantasy or history in a manner that evokes the theme of our event. Games should be exciting and most of all, FUN! Please describe your game or activity in detail. If possible please provide a photo.
